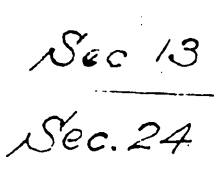

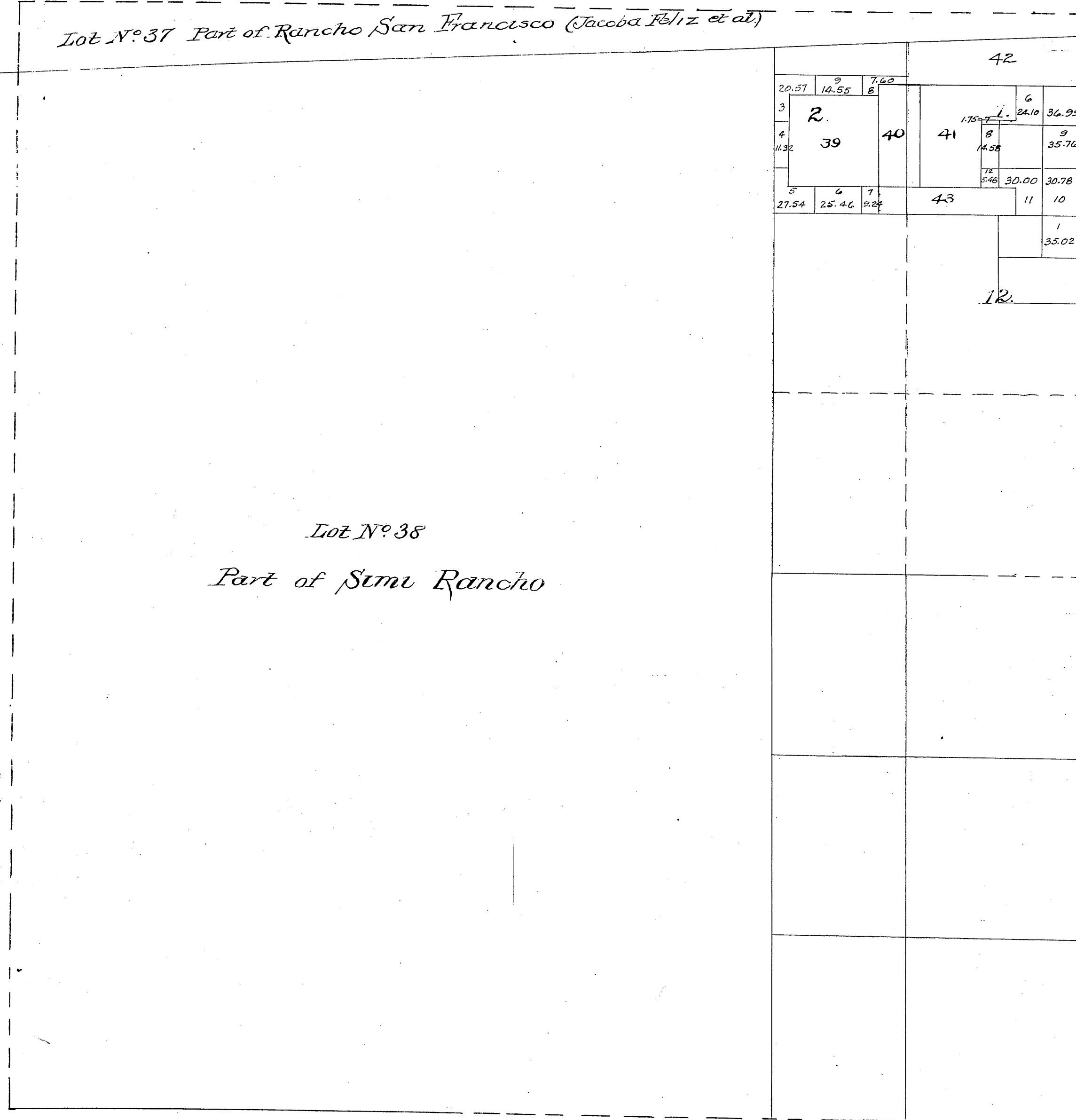

Lot N°37 Part of Rancho San Francisco (Jacoba Feliz et al.)



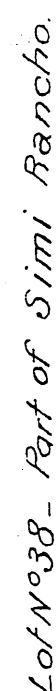

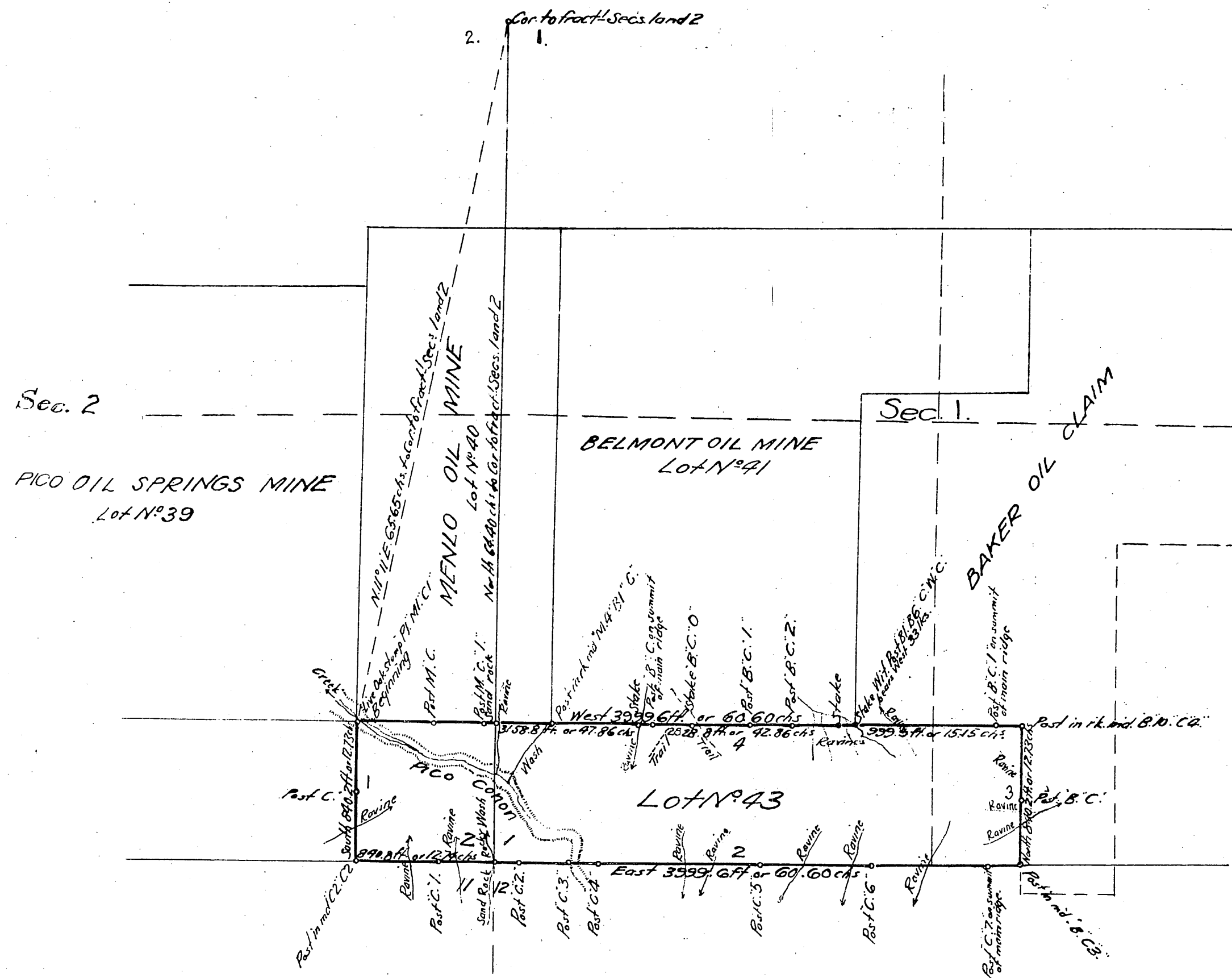

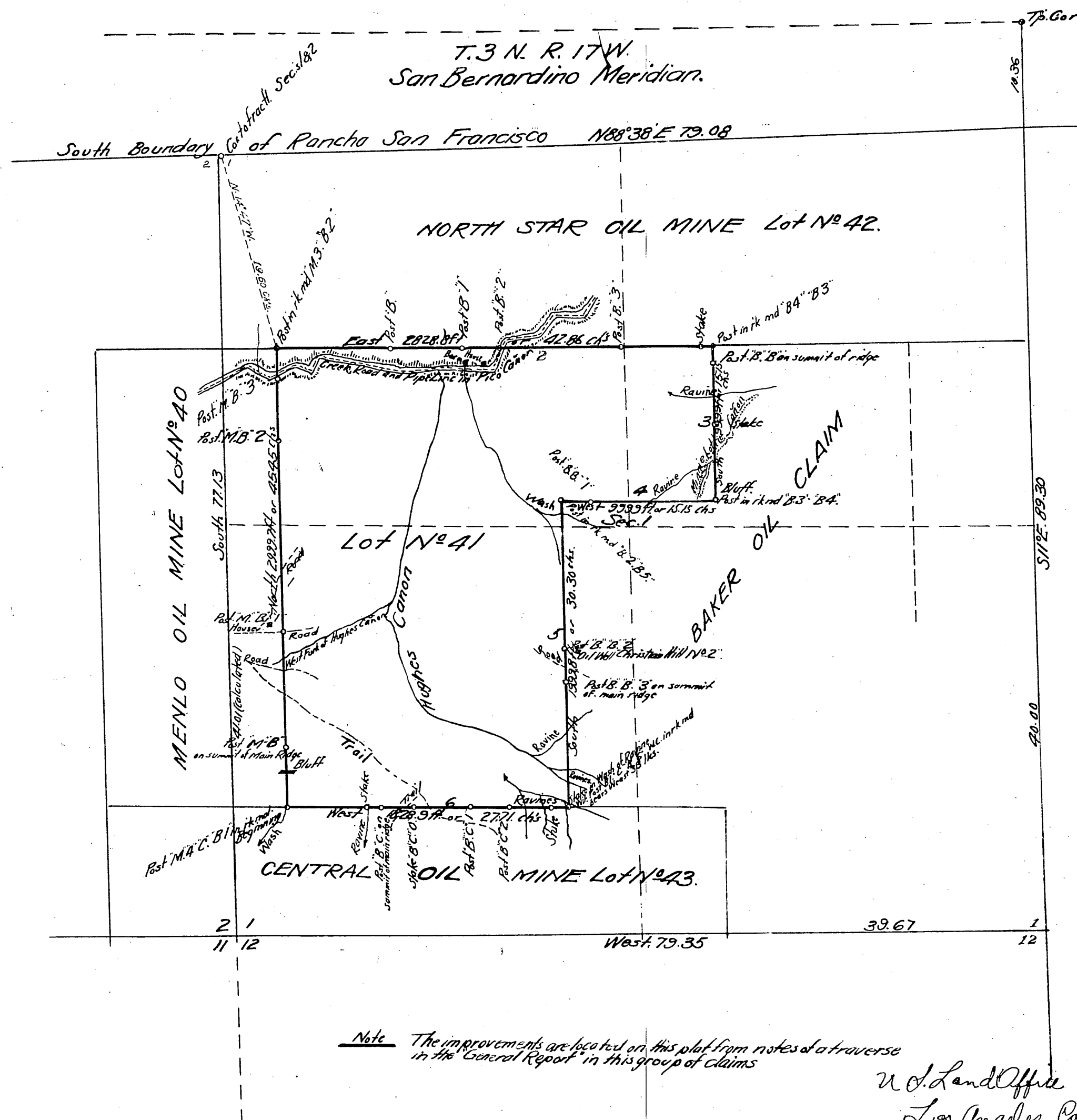
